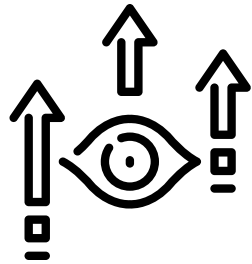
The industry dealt with curveball after curveball. Everything from factory fires to production delays blindsided the industry and punched holes in the already-sensitive supply chain.

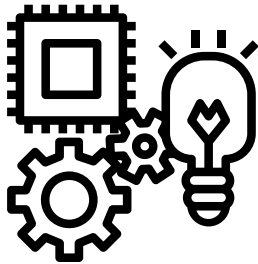
